WHY JOIN?

Designed with the intent to increase success for students moving from high school to college, this residential program effectively bridges student's academic and social lives by creating an academic cohort for students who live and learn together.

In Fall 2017, a maximum of 16 students will be invited to join this living-learning community. The students will take two of their courses each semester, as a cohort, in the residence hall.
